Chamber of Cannabis Industry Ghana (CannaCham)
On Recent United States Executive Action to Expand Medical Cannabis
and Cannabidiol (CBD) Research

The Chamber of Cannabis Industry Ghana welcomes the recent Executive Action by the Government of the United States to expand and prioritize scientific research into medical marijuana and cannabidiol (CBD).

This policy direction by one of the world's leading regulatory and scientific jurisdictions reinforces the growing global consensus that cannabis has legitimate medical and industrial applications when governed by robust, evidence-based regulation.

For Ghana, this development is timely and instructive. It strengthens the case for accelerating the full operationalization of Ghana's medical and industrial cannabis framework under LI 2470, deepening research collaborations, strengthening standards, and supporting responsible private sector participation across the value chain.

The Chamber reiterates its support for a strictly regulated, public-health-oriented cannabis industry that promotes:

- scientific research and clinical evidence,
- compliance with international standards,
- investment into value-addition and export-oriented activities, and
- job creation and industrial development.

We respectfully encourage Ghanaian regulators, policymakers, and stakeholders to continue engaging constructively with industry players, research institutions, and international partners to ensure that Ghana remains competitive, compliant, and well-positioned within the evolving global medical cannabis ecosystem.
